Dear Family Member,

We are proud to begin a new school year. Welcome!

The purpose of this letter is to tell you about the reading program your student will be using this year. The program is an innovative set of instructional materials. If your student attended our school in either Kindergarten or Grade 1, they probably used this program for reading instruction in those grades. The program consists of two types of instruction every day:

- *Conocimientos* Strand. The sixty-minute *Conocimientos* Strand builds general knowledge, vocabulary, and other language skills.
- *Habilidades y destrezas* Strand. Its duration is forty minutes; Basic reading, writing, spelling and grammar skills are developed.

During the first few weeks, we will review the skills learned in Grade 1. This review period will give us the opportunity to get to know your student better, and identify their specific strengths and areas of growth in the reading and writing process. It is important to determine the appropriate level of instruction for your student.

This week, your student will take home copies of a story we have read together in class. We hope that you will read the stories together again, out loud, and talk about them at home. However, if your student has difficulty reading the stories and seems to become frustrated, please read the stories out loud to them. We will be observing and assessing your student during the first few weeks. You will be able to be aware of their learning, since your student will regularly take home work that they have done in class and some tasks that they will do at home.

It is important that parents or caregivers be involved in the education of their students. If you would like more information about how you can help your student at home, please feel free to contact us. You will continue to receive periodic letters that will give you tips and activities to do with your student. We look forward to the start of Grade 2 classes!
